

Free H1N1 Flu Clinic



Saturday December 19 from 1 PM – 4 PM
Keene High School, 43 Arch Street

This H1N1 vaccine clinic is being held for Keene High School students. Students less than 18 years of age must have their parent/guardian sign the consent form to receive the vaccine. Students can pick up a consent form in the school nurse's office, or have their parent/guardian accompany them to the clinic and sign the form there. KHS staff/faculty and KHS students' siblings and parents/ guardians who meet the criteria for Phases I, II, and III of the NH DHHS H1N1 vaccine distribution plan are welcome to attend this clinic. These phases include:

- All children and young adults ages 4 years* – 24 years of age
- Adults 25 – 64 years of age with underlying medical conditions
- Pregnant women and their partners
- People caring for or living with infants younger than 6 months
- Healthcare workers and EMS/first responders

* Parents/guardians of children 6 months – 3 years should contact their pediatricians.
