**SCHOOLS BEGIN WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2010
(Keene Elementary Schools: Kindergarten begins Tuesday, September 7)**

1. Opportunity to Register

- a. All pupils not previously registered should be registered by August 31. Pupils in attendance at the close of the school year 2009-2010 are not required to register again.
- b. Children registered for Kindergarten in April 2010, are not required to register again.
Keene: Kindergarten Screenings Tuesday, August 31 and Wednesday, September 1
(Contact your school for appointment)
- c. However, any change in address during the summer months within the City of Keene should be reported to the principal in the school area now residing.
- d. School personnel will be available most days at all **KEENE** and **WESTMORELAND** schools to register new pupils. (A telephone call to the school prior to going is recommended to ensure someone is available or to make an appointment for registering your children).
- e. Students in **CHESTERFIELD** may register **between August 16-20, 2010, from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.**

Students in **HARRISVILLE** may register **Friday, August 20, 2010, from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

Students in **MARLBOROUGH** may register **Wednesday, August 18, 2010, from 9:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m.**

Students in **MARLOW** may register **Wednesday, August 11, 2010, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.** and **Wednesday, August 18, 2010, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.**

Students in **NELSON** may register **Wednesday & Thursday, August 18 & 19, 2010, from 9:00 to 11:00 a.m.**

2. Special Requirements

- a. Birth certificates must be submitted for new pupils in Kindergarten and Grade 1. Proof of residency (i.e., current utility bill, lease, pay stub, etc.) must be submitted for *all* new students.
- b. Entrance age -- Children residing in **Chesterfield, Harrisville, Keene, Marlborough, Marlow, Nelson and Westmoreland:** Kindergarten, at least five by September 30, 2010; Grade 1, at least 6 by September 30, 2010. **In Keene, proof of residency of the student and/or his/her legal guardian(s) will be required by the school Principal at the time of registration and annually thereafter.**
- c. New Hampshire R.S.A. 200:32 requires "**There shall be a complete medical examination by a licensed physician of each child prior to or upon first entry into the public school system.**"
- d. New Hampshire R.S.A. 200:38 requires "**All children shall be immunized prior to school entrance according to the current recommendations of the state public health agency.**"
